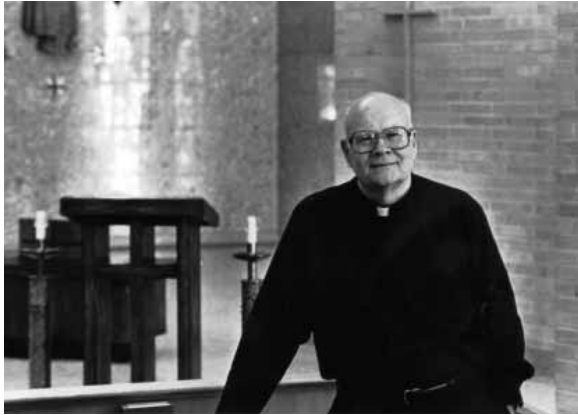


## Meet Father Daniel McCaffrey



Father Daniel McCaffrey was ordained in 1958. A year later he departed for the Moslem country of Pakistan where he served for over eight years as a missionary. Father holds a Doctorate in Sacred Theology from the University of St. Thomas Aquinas (Angelicum) in Rome. In 1968, during the Vietnam Conflict Father joined the United States Army Chaplain Corps. During more than twenty years of active duty he served in Vietnam, Korea, Germany and Honduras, as well as numerous army installations throughout the United States.

During his ministry he has worked in the Apostolate of Marriage Enrichment establishing successful Natural Family Planning programs on the diocesan and parish levels. Father is a priest of the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City.

## What is a mission?

A mission is the opportunity for a guest preacher to evangelize your parish in a special way by bringing new insights to age-old truths and providing intense times for prayer and spiritual growth through the sacraments of the Eucharist, Reconciliation and preaching.

## Why a mission now?

Pope John Paul II has called upon the members of Christ's faithful to respond to a new evangelization that begins first of all on the personal, family and parish levels. With the recent publication of *The Catechism of the Catholic Church*, the first universal catechism in 400 years, a parish mission centered on the core of Catholic teaching is an ideal way to launch this renewed effort in evangelization.

## How does a mission work?

Here is a suggested schedule:

### Saturday and Sunday Masses:

Father McCaffrey preaches on how we can be part of the Catholic evangelization effort so desired by Pope John Paul II.

### Sunday-Wednesday Evenings:

7:30 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.

**Sunday:** What the Catholic Church believes (The Creed)

**Monday:** What the Catholic Church celebrates (Sacraments)

**Tuesday:** What the Catholic Church lives (Commandments, Natural Family Planning and its impact on marriage and family life)

**Wednesday:** What the Catholic Church prays (the Our Father, prayer, spiritual life)

*Schedule is flexible, according to local needs*

*Confessions at opportune times*

*If requested, Father McCaffrey will make available enjoyable videos on the lives of the Saints while adults attend the mission talks.*
